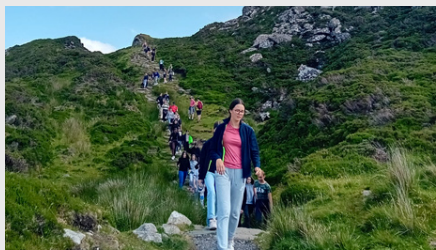
English & Surfing

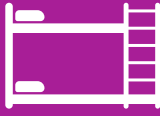

Three separate residential properties owned and managed by DELS

Surfers Bay



- **Surfers Bay** is our main residential accommodation with 21 bedrooms.
- **15 minutes walk** from the school and **5 minutes** from the centre of town.
- **Sleeps up to 48 students** in shared rooms of various sizes.
- Student floors will be separated by gender.
- Large games room and communal space.
- Organic garden.
- Outdoor activity dome.
- Managed and monitored by coordinators 24/7

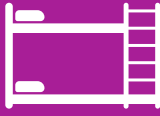
Portbeg Houses



- **3 minutes walk** from the school and **15 minutes** from the centre of town.
- **Sleeps 8 - 11 students per house** and one coordinator per house.
- Each house has four bedrooms, three to four bathrooms, a spacious kitchen and communal areas.
- Located along the coast.
- Scenic coastal cliff walk into town.

Bundoran Holiday Centre

- **15 minutes walk** from the school.
- Located in the heart of Bundoran town.

- Has 17 spacious bedrooms, all ensuite.
- Large communal area and kitchen.

Host Family



- All Host families **live within 20 minutes** of the school.
- Students will have a room either to themselves or shared with other students.
- Students have the chance to see local attractions and immerse themselves in the Irish culture.
- Each Host Family will provide breakfast and dinner for the students staying with them (They will have lunch in the canteen).
- Students will be dropped off by their Host in the mornings and our Host Family bus will bring them home in the evenings.

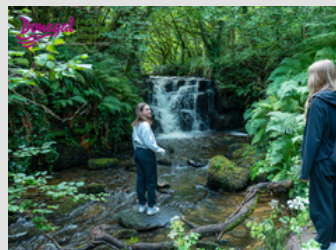
